

Okeechobee Hometown Hero Banner Application

To qualify for a banner, honorees must meet the following requirements:

Active or deceased honorably discharged military personnel of the United States Armed Forces and lives or have lived in Okeechobee County. Proof of being an Okeechobee County Veteran may be required.

Only 58 Banners are available. Each application submission should be placed in its own labeled manila or large white envelope. **Banners are first come first serve with completed applications only.** The price per banner is \$40.00. After hanging of the banners in Downtown Okeechobee, the banner will be yours to keep.

Please bring you labeled envelope including: Application, picture of Veteran (preferably be in uniform), and payment to Okeechobee Main Street at 111 NE 2nd Street during regular business hours. Make checks payable to Okeechobee Main Street. Credit Cards and Cash will also be accepted.
